The Piton International Film Festival (PIFF) was founded by Edmund Umoja Herman, a born Lucian. Inspired by the words of the late Sir John Compton, who challenged Lucians overseas to help build their homeland into a better place, Mr. Herman, known as Brother Umoja, actively began building relationships, throughout the globe, with his fellow Lucians in the 1990's and started seeking ways to showcase their talents as well as improve opportunities available to them.

The purpose of PIFF is threefold. First, PIFF is a family-friendly event that encourages unity within families, giving them an opportunity to watch, discuss, learn, and enjoy films together. Second, PIFF is part of a 12-month initiative that focuses on celebrating, educating, exploring, and understanding the various aspects that are needed in the production of filmmaking. Third, PIFF works to create economic and employment opportunities for individuals on the island of St. Lucia and throughout the global community by working collaboratively with individuals involved in filmmaking and with film festivals.
